Jonah

So they picked up Jonah and hurled him into the sea, and the sea ceased from its raging. . . . And the Lord appointed a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

~ Jonah 1:15, 17

God wanted Jonah to be His prophet, to go and call the people of a city named Nineveh to repent of their sins and evils. But Jonah didn't think that was a very good idea at all! In fact, Jonah thought God was wrong - that the people of Nineveh did not deserve God's forgiveness. So Jonah ran away from God. He got into a boat and sailed the opposite direction from Nineveh.

But God knew where He was. So He caused a great storm to come upon the sea until the men of the ship threw Jonah overboard. Then God had a great fish swallow Jonah because He didn't want Jonah to die - He wanted Jonah to repent himself and then go preach to the people of Nineveh. So God used the water of the sea and a fish that He created that lived in that water to help the people of Nineveh. It worked! The people of Nineveh repented and were saved.

Jonah gives us a picture of what Jesus has done for us. Jesus came to win the forgiveness of sins for us by His death and the cross and His resurrection from the dead. And in between, being swallowed up by death and the grave for three days, just like Jonah. But also just like Jonah, God's plan worked! Because of Jesus, we have forgiveness, life, and salvation. So don't run away from God like Jonah did. Repent of your sin and rejoice in the love and forgiveness He has for you!

Russia

Russia is one of the largest countries in the world; it is also one of the thirstiest! For like the Baltic States that we learned about on Tuesday, the people of Russia were under the control of the Soviet Union for 70 years, during which Christians were punished severely. One church in St. Petersburg was even converted into a swimming pool! The government also created Sunday activities that the children were required to attend, so they could not go to church. If the children did not go, they would be barred from school and could not get a job. So many children were forced away from the church in this way! Now their children need to learn about Jesus.
