Jesus is Baptized

Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heavens were opened, and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form, like a dove; and a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

~ Luke 3:21-22

Why did Jesus need to be baptized? That's a question many people ask. If He was not a sinner (and He wasn't!), then why be baptized with sinners? The answer is that in being baptized with sinners, Jesus is identifying Himself with us, for He has come to be one of us and to take our place under God's Law and its obligation - to fulfill it all perfectly in our place. But this, too: the water of baptism washes our sins off us, but washes them onto Jesus! We get clean in the water of baptism, but Jesus gets dirty! So Jesus isn't baptized for Himself. He didn't need it. He is baptized for us, because we needed a Saviour! And with His baptism, Jesus is being that Saviour.

Notice, also, what the Father says when Jesus does this; when He identifies Himself with sinners and gets our sins washed upon Him. The Father is pleased! Yes, for this is exactly why Jesus came. He came to do this, for us, and be our Saviour. What wonderful water baptism is!

China

Did you ever play hide and seek? Of course you have! It's a fun game. But for the people in China, it's not so fun. They have to play hide and seek with the Chinese government when they go to church. The government doesn't want them to be Christians or go to church, so they and their churches have to hide, while the government tries to find them and stop them. It is a dangerous game for them, but Jesus is so important to them that they are willing to do that! Would you?



But since that's how things are in China, Bibles and Sunday School materials are very hard to get. But the children there need them! It is possible to get these books and materials to them, but it must be done very carefully and secretly. It is worth the effort and risk, so that the children and people of China can know their Saviour.
