Jesus Heals a Deaf Man

There are people with problems that we can see and know about, and some people whose problems are hidden - like the deaf man in our story today. Just looking at him, you wouldn't know anything was wrong. But Jesus knows. He can see what we cannot. So when this man's friends bring him to Jesus, Jesus indicates He knows what's wrong, and heals the man - instantly and fully! Suddenly he can both hear and speak.

Here's part of that story . . .

Then he returned from the region of Tyre and went through Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, in the region of the Decapolis. And they brought to him a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment, and they begged him to lay his hand on him. And taking him aside from the crowd privately, he put his fingers into his ears, and after spitting touched his tongue. And looking up to heaven, he sighed and said to him, "Ephphatha," that is, "Be opened." And his ears were opened, his tongue was released, and he spoke plainly. . . .

We hear, too. There are so many sounds we take for granted. But imagine not being able to hear. What would you miss hearing the most? But here's another question: What's the most important thing you can hear? The answer is: The Word of God! For God's Word is what can help us not only now, but give us everlasting life. That's why we read God's Word so much in Vacation Bible School.



The sense we thought a little about today was **hearing**. This is a more important sense than we sometimes realize. For do you know how we learn how to speak? By hearing! We hear our parents speak to us as babies and imitate them. So if you can't hear, you can't speak. We're learning how all of our senses are separate but also work together. It's that way in church, too. There are things we see, things we hear, things we smell, things we touch, and things we taste! God comes to us through all our senses! How about that?

What will tomorrow's sense be? There's only two left!
